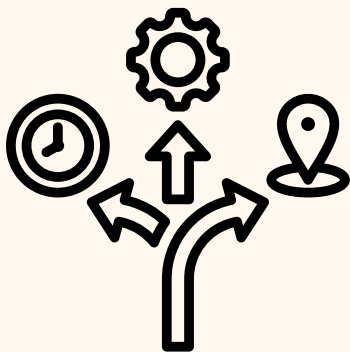


01 Personal Freedom and Flexibility

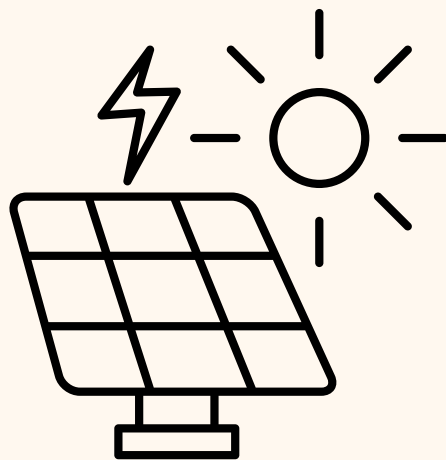


03 Sustainable Living

This diversity can lead to a richer cultural tapestry, with vehicle residents sharing stories, experiences, and perspectives from various backgrounds.



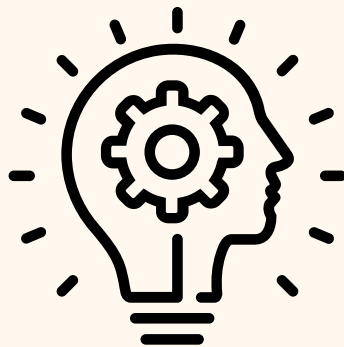


05 Innovation and Resilience

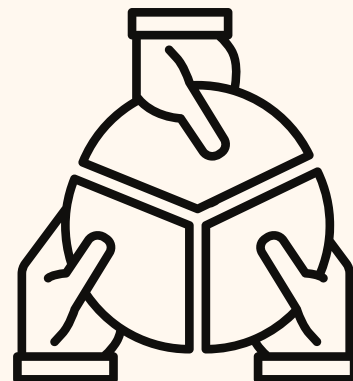
Skill Sharing and Community Building

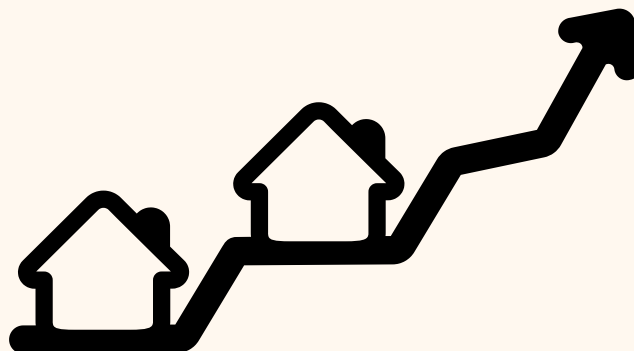
Building relationships between stationary residents and vehicle residents can foster a supportive network where everyone thrives.
